# College Activities....

## First General Meeting with the Teachers :

## Academic Extension Programme :



An MoU has been signed between Padmanath Gohain Baruah Govt. Model College, Kakopathar and Dirak Higher Secondary School as a part of academic extension program on 28th January, 2021. Accordingly, the Departments of English and Assamese provided remedial classes for one month to the students of Higher Secondary First and Second Years in Dirak H.S. School in February, 2021. Along with the principal Dr. Thanu Ram Majinder and the teachers, journalist Mr. Dhiren Deka, Dr. Miladev Goswami, reputed physician and Mr. Arjun Baruah, President of Assam Sahitya Sabha, Tinsukia Branch were present in the meeting.

## Guardian Meeting :

The first guardian meeting was held in the college on 30th January, 2021. Moderated by Mr. Bituraj Gohain, Assistant Professor of the Department of Education, the meeting was presided over by the principal Dr. Thanu Ram Majinder. ### A talk on India's Freedom Struggle :

In this session, Ms. Ila Deka, Head of the Department of Political Science, delivered a speech on the topic "The Glorious History of India's Freedom Struggle". In her talk, she explained the prolonged struggle of India for independence from the Sepoy Mutiny to the Quit India Movement of 1942. Dr. Dipen Basumatary, Assistant Professor of the Department of Sociology, delivered a talk on the rise of nationalism in India's freedom struggle and also on the reform movements of India during the colonial period. Another talk was delivered by Ms. Krishna Saikia, Assistant Professor of the Department of Economics on the topic "Role of Bhagat Singh in India's Freedom Struggle".

### Awareness Program on Improvement of Management Information System :

### Celebration of the Foundation Day of the College :

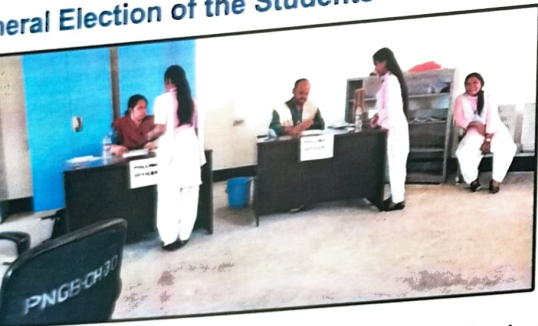

### Celebration of Silpi Divas :



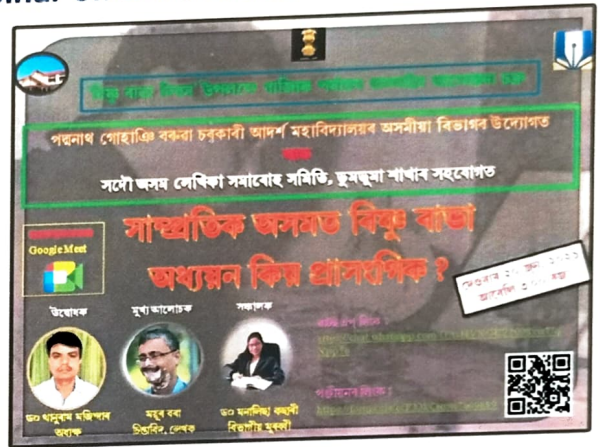

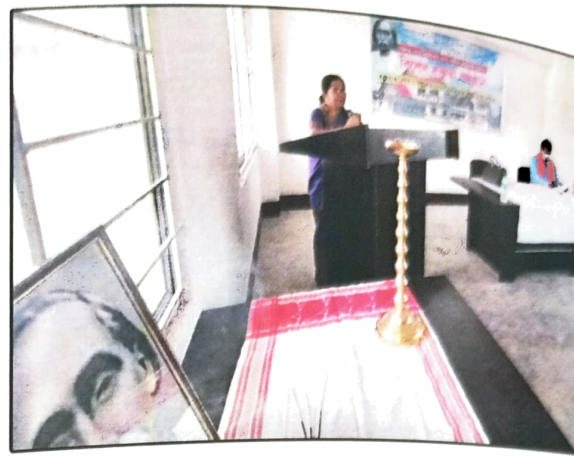
**Observation of the Death Anniversary of Dr. Bhupen Hazarika :**

In connection with the 75th Death Anniversary of Padmanath Gohain Baruah, a tree plantation program was also organised in the college campus.

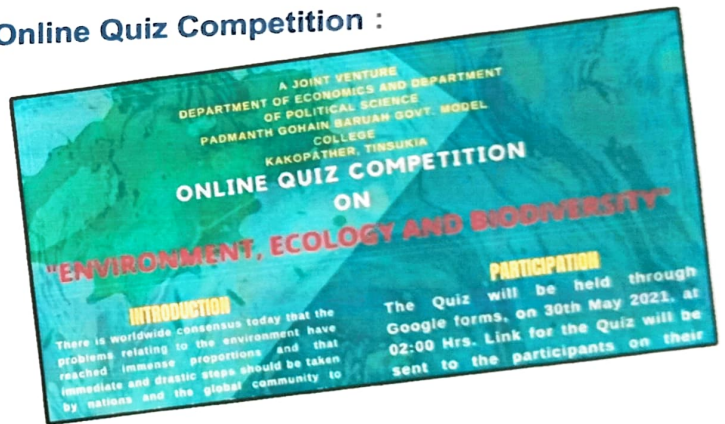

### Department of Economics :

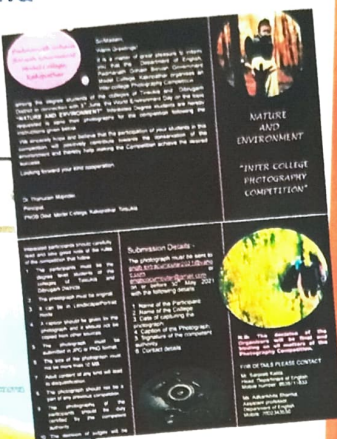
#### Online Quiz Competition :

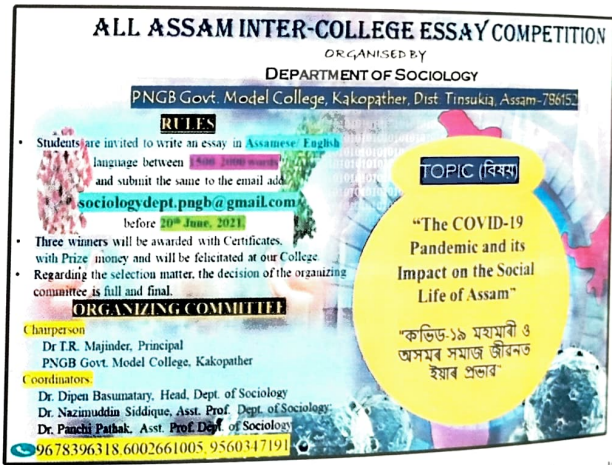
**Photography Competition and Webinar in connection with World Environmental Day :**

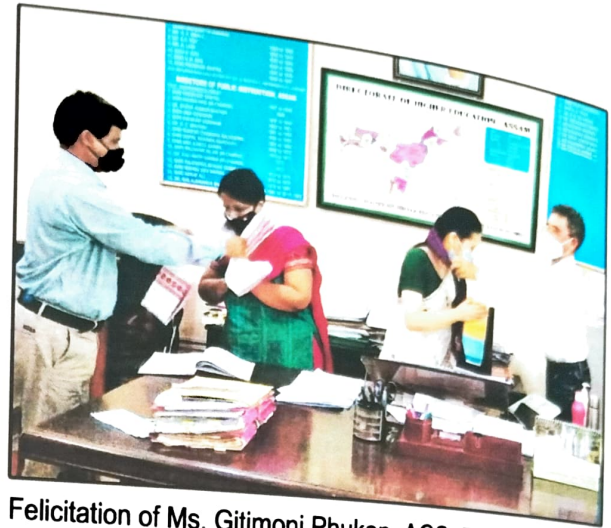

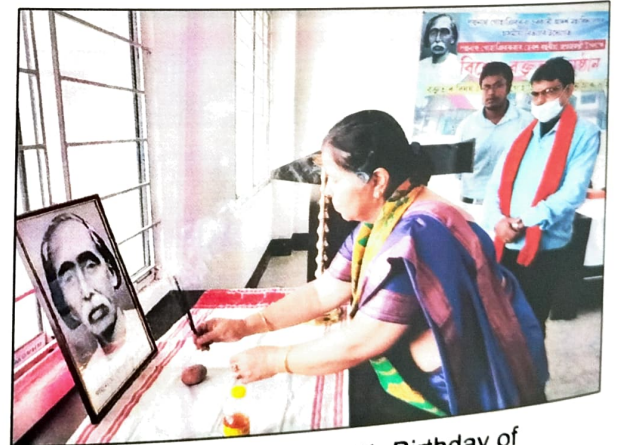

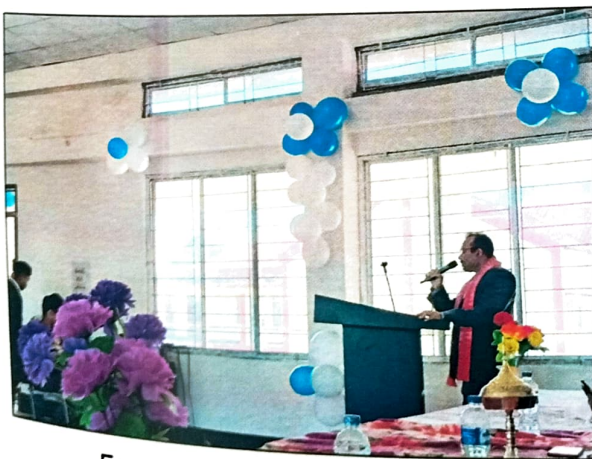
